

Course Compass/My Math Lab

There are 4 things to do in your On-Line portion:

- Pre-Tests
- Post-Tests
- Quizzes
- Study Plan

There is only 1 thing that “officially” counts toward your grade:

Quizzes

Pre-Tests & Post-Tests are “Extra Credit”

- 20% of your “grade” will be added to your quiz scores if Pre/Post Test scores exceed you quiz scores
- 1st Bullet Point Means: If quiz score is 70%, and you get 90% on Pre/Post Tests then your final My Math Lab % will be 88%.
- You will not be allowed over 100% credit for My Math Lab
- You can continue to do Pre/Post Tests improving your scores through until Sunday, Dec. 15

Due Dates:

- Only Quizzes have due dates throughout the semester. Due on Sundays.
- Pre-Tests & Post-Tests must be complete by Sunday, December 15

Quiz restrictions:

- 1 try only
- 60 minutes time limit
- Once you begin a question you must complete it or it will be marked wrong
- You do have save for later option, but you still can't go backward to already viewed questions

Pre/Post Test & Study Plan Suggestions

- Start Pre-Test as we are beginning the chapter
- Work the Post-Test as soon as we finish the chapter
- Work on the Study Plan Quiz Me & Problems between finishing Post-Test & taking Quizzes

To register for Canada M811--F13:

1. Go to pearsonmylabandmastering.com.
2. Under Register, click **Student**.
3. Enter your instructor's course ID: [butterworth81246](#), and click **Continue**.
4. Sign in with an existing Pearson account or create an account:
 - If you have used a Pearson website (for example, MyITLab, Mastering, MyMathLab, or MyPsychLab), enter your Pearson username and password. Click **Sign In**.
 - If you do not have a Pearson account, click **Create**. Write down your new Pearson username and password to help you remember them.
